Introduction

Food scraps generated at BWI are being diverted from the landfill to a composting facility.

Acceptable material can be from both kitchen prep and leftovers from restaurant guests.

Food scraps need to be separated and placed outside in the **GREEN** bins on the airfield.

BWI Food Scrap Composting Program

YES: All food prep materials, dropped, old, burned, or inedible food



Bread, Pasta,
& Rolls



Coffee Grounds
& Filters



Potatoes & Fries



Cheese



Meat & Bones



Vegetables & Fruits



Paper Towels



Seafood



Sandwiches

NO: Plastic/chip bags, non-food items, plastic, metal, grease, or trash

Food Scrap Collection Guide – Grab & Go

- 1) Place container in your kitchen area
- 2) Place food scraps from meal prep in container
 - **Do NOT** place plastic or metal in container
 - Kitchen containers and compostable bags cannot be provided
- 3) Take food scraps to designated location on airfield
- 4) Place food scraps in **GREEN** bin
 - Either use a compostable bag or dump contents into **GREEN** bin



Food Scrap Collection Guide – Sit Down

- 1) Place container in your kitchen area
- 2) Place food scraps from meal prep and patrons in container
 - **Do NOT** place plastic or metal in container
 - Kitchen containers and compostable bags cannot be provided
- 3) Take food scraps to designated location on airfield
- 4) Place food scraps in **GREEN** bin
 - Either use a compostable bag or dump contents into **GREEN** bin



Food Scrap Collection Bin Locations (GREEN)

→ A Concourse

- A Dock – 1 bin
 - i. Mayorga
- A8 – 2 bins
 - i. Tony & Benny's
 - ii. Green Beans A

→ E Concourse

- E1 – 2 bins
 - i. Passports

*Additional bins can be placed in new locations as more restaurants participate in the program.

→ B Concourse

- B Dock – 2 bins
 - i. Arby's
- B7 – 6 bins
 - i. Obrycki's

→ C Concourse

- C5 – 1 bin
 - i. Einstein's
- C7 – 1 bin
 - i. Harbor Grille
