## **BWI Thurgood Marshall Airport D/E Connector and Security Checkpoint**

**WHERE:** Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport

**WHAT:** BWI Marshall Airport is moving forward with a series of terminal improvements to support additional international air service and to enhance passenger convenience. The D/E Connector and Security Checkpoint program includes several elements: the construction of a new secure connector between concourses D and E; the configuration of airline gates to support additional international flights; the creation of a new security checkpoint to serve domestic and international travelers; and the renovation and widening of the “throat” portion of Concourse D in order to comply with updated building code requirements.

**WHY:** The improvements will position airline gates and associated support facilities to meet existing and projected demand for international air service. International passenger traffic has grown steadily in recent years at BWI Marshall. Further international growth is expected in the near term.

**WHEN:** Design work on the D/E Connector program is to be completed in the summer of 2014. Construction is expected to start in the winter of 2014-2015. The preliminary schedule for the D/E Connector and Security Checkpoint program calls for completion in 2017.

**COST:** **Total: \$125 million**
