## Kirk Bus Division Modernization Project – Phase 2

**WHERE:** Baltimore City

**WHAT:** Constructing a new Kirk Bus Division transportation and storage building to accommodate approximately 175 buses, including articulated / hybrid vehicles. The new facility will be constructed on the existing Kirk Division site to minimize the impact on the community and to increase MTA efficiency and operations.

**WHY:** The new Kirk Bus Division will replace the existing facility, originally constructed in 1947, and will allow for all MTA bus operations to take place inside new facilities to address community concerns related to bus visibility, noise and emissions.

**WHEN:** Phase 1: Maintenance Building construction began fall 2013 and will be complete in 2015.  
Phase 2: Transportation / Storage Building construction is expected to begin fall 2015 and be complete in 2017

**COST:** **Construction: \$75 million for Phase 2 (\$65 million already funded for Phase 1)**  
**Transportation Infrastructure Investment Act**

**Total: \$139.5 million**  
**(Federal: \$93.3 million, State: \$46.2 million)**
