MARC Train Penn Line Weekend Service

WHERE: Baltimore / Washington, D.C.

WHAT: Launching first ever weekend service on the MARC Train Penn Line. The service will operate 9 round trips on Saturdays and 6 round trips on Sundays.

WHY: Weekend MARC Train service will build on Governor Martin O'Malley's pledge to double transit ridership by 2020. The new service fills a void in weekend public transit alternatives for passengers visiting or commuting between Baltimore and Washington, D.C. It also will enhance access to BWI Marshall Airport.

WHEN: **Weekend service began Saturday, December 7, 2013.**

Saturday will offer 9 round trips between Penn Station and Union Station:

- Penn Station Departures – 7:35 a.m. to 9:15 p.m.
- Union Station Departures – 9:02 a.m. to 10:35 p.m.

Sunday will offer 6 round trips between Penn Station and Union Station:

- Penn Station Departures – 9:15 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
- Union Station Departures – 10:40 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Stations served: Martin State Airport, Baltimore (Penn Station), West Baltimore, Halethorpe, BWI, Odenton, Bowie, New Carrollton and Washington, D.C. (Union Station)

COST: **Operating: \$46 million (fiscal years 2014 - 2019)**
Transportation Infrastructure Investment Act

FARES: **\$7 one-way fare between Baltimore and Washington, D.C.**
