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I-695 Inner Loop Bridge Replacements and Interchange Improvements

WHERE: Baltimore County

WHAT: Replacing two I-695 Inner Loop bridges over Benson and Leeds avenues / US 1 / Amtrak in southwestern Baltimore County. Work also includes reconstructing the Leeds Avenue ramp to the Inner Loop of I-695 to provide a new connection via US 1.

WHY: The project will replace and widen the aging bridges, built in 1957, which will improve mobility and save on future maintenance needs. The Leeds Avenue ramp to the Inner Loop of I-695 will be realigned and connect via US 1, which will enhance traffic operations and safety in the Arbutus area. Currently, these I-695 bridges carry 202,200 vehicles per day, with traffic projected to increase to 247,800 vehicles per day.

WHEN: Construction begins late fall 2014 and will be complete summer 2017, weather permitting.

COST: \$56.7 Million (\$44.8 Million Federal / \$11.86 Million State)

Construction: \$52.2 Million
