The Kenilworth Aquatic Gardens Trail segment is the final missing link in an almost 60-mile network of bicycle and pedestrian trails in the District of Columbia and Maryland. This new connection will create new options for bicycle commuters and bring economic and health benefits to nearby communities.

A \$10-million U.S. Department of Transportation TIGER (Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery) Grant, combined with \$3.5 million from the District and \$1.5 million from Maryland, will fund construction of the four-mile trail segment between Benning Road in the District and Bladensburg Waterfront Park in Bladensburg, Maryland.
