
In accordance with the provisions of Title 23, United States Code, Section 210, and regulations issued by the Secretary of Transportation, and under the authority delegated by the Secretary of Defense, I hereby certify as important to national defense the following described access roads at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland:

Access road beginning at the intersection of State Route 175 (Annapolis Road) and State Route 174 (Reese Road), extending sufficiently north, south, east and west to provide appropriate turning lanes and other necessary intersection modifications.

Access road beginning at the intersection of State Route 175 (Annapolis Road) and Mapes Road/Charter Oaks Boulevard, extending sufficiently north, south, east and west to provide appropriate turning lanes and other necessary intersection modifications.

The project has a defense material priority rating of three. The purpose of this certification is to provide for the access road improvements as described in your Mar 10 evaluation. This certification is made with the understanding that improvements must comply with applicable anti-terrorism/force protection regulations, and that maintenance of the access road will be the responsibility of the owning highway authorities.
