



**MINUTES OF THE
MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
March 7, 2012**

The September meeting of the Maryland Transportation Commission (MTC) was held on March 7, 2012 at 10:30AM in the Board Room of the Maryland Department of Transportation. The following members were present.

Due to the extensive amount of people testifying, Vice Chairman VillaSanta called the meeting to order at 10:47AM. Mr. VillaSanta then asked Mr. Beam, staff to the Commission, if there were any dedication requests for presentation to the Commission.

Mr. Beam presented Sergeant Toya M. Adams of the Maryland State Police (MSP) on behalf of Trooper First Class (TFC) Wesley Washington John Brown, also of the Maryland State Police. The location requested is on I-495 in the vicinity of Forestville Road.

TFC Brown was a decorated member of the Forestville State Police Barrack in Prince George's County. On June 11, 2010, TFC Brown was shot and killed in a secondary law enforcement employment position as a security officer for an area restaurant. The incident took place as revenge for having escorted an unruly patron out of the restaurant earlier in the evening. The individual has since been convicted of the murder of TFC Brown.

TFC Brown's family and MSP commanders and co-workers testified extensively to the Commission regarding the life, character and service of Wesley Brown and the impact and legacy he had as a transformative member of the Forestville Community, both in and out of uniform.

The MTC voted unanimously to respectfully recommend approving this request as the members felt that a dedication was indeed warranted.

Hearing no other items of business, the Commission adjourned at 12:03PM until 10:30AM on March 7, 2012.
