The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby administratively modifies the FY 2010 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program to reflect an administrative modification to the WILMAPCO FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program to include a resurfacing project on US Route 222 in Cecil County. The modification was approved by WILMAPCO on July 19, 2010. The project will be completed using previously approved unspent contingency funds provided through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.
