The Maryland Department of Transportation has requested an administrative modification, as attached, to the FY 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This request is to add federal funding designated for Morgan State University Transportation Center's National Summer Transportation Institute Implementation Plan. These federal funds are designated for this program and cannot be used for any other project. Fiscal constraint is not an issue as all of the identified funds are federal funds.

In order to meet the intent of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users and the requirements of the Metropolitan Planning Regulations, documentation has been submitted by the requesting jurisdiction. As this project is an educational program, the Interagency Consultation Group has determined in a past TIP that it is exempt from the requirement to determine conformity according to the Conformity Rule (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93).

Approval of this administrative modification to the Baltimore Region FY 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program was given by the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board's Executive Committee on May 5, 2011.

We are requesting an administrative modification to the FY 2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to reflect the programming of federal funds. These funds have been made available to fund the National Summer Transportation Institute Implementation Plan for the Morgan State University Transportation Center. This program will utilize \$41,095 of federal funds in FY 2011.

The Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program continues to be fiscally constrained. The project is already included in an approved TIP and, therefore, further conformity analysis is not required as a result of this modification. Furthermore, the addition of these funds will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current TIP. The cost does not affect the portion of federal funding, which was programmed for transit, or any allocations of state aid in lieu of federal aid to local jurisdictions. 
Dear Mr. Halligan:
