The Regional and Intermodal Planning Division (RIPD) would like to submit the following amendment to the FY 2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP):

- The addition of \$13.5 million in funding in support of Right-of-Way for Phase II of the MD 2/4 Project which extends from Fox Run Boulevard to Commerce Lane on Solomons Island Road in Calvert County.

Project funding will be flowed \$6,750,000 programmed in FY 2014 and \$6,750,000 programmed in FY 2015. This funding for this amendment is due to an increase in federal aid obligation authority assumptions. 


Dear Mr. Halligan:
