The first phase will be the construction of a storage facility.

Project Justification: This project enables the MTA to more efficiently maintain MARC vehicles, and thus deliver better service on the MARC system.

RESOLUTION BY THE WILMINGTON AREA PLANNING COUNCIL (WILMAPCO)

AMENDING THE FY2014-17 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM, CECIL COUNTY ELEMENT

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Area Planning Council (WILMAPCO) has been designated the Metropolitan Planning Organization for Cecil County, Maryland and New Castle County, Delaware by the Governors of Maryland and Delaware, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation's (USDOT) Regulations of Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21), Metropolitan Planning Requirements, require that, in air quality non-attainment areas, the MPO, in cooperation with participants in the planning process, develop and, at least every four years, updates the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the WILMAPCO TIP format incorporates a four-year period for the listing of priority projects to be implemented, as well as a list of program development projects; and


WHEREAS, the amendment to the FY 2014-17 TIP has undergone appropriate community and technical reviews; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the TIP has been determined to be air quality conforming in accordance with MAP-21 and Clean Air Act and Amendments (CAAA) of 1990 requirements; and;

WHEREAS, the amendment to the FY 2014-17 TIP have been found to be financially constrained, as directed by 23 CFR 450.324 (e), and consistent with the Regional Transportation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wilmington Area Planning Council does hereby amend the FY 2014-17 Transportation Improvement Program to include funding for the MARC Maintenance and Layover Facility.

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) requested approval of various Amendments to the FY 2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (Control#13-123, 124, and 126 dated January 30, 2014 and February 12, 2014). The Amendments add various capital projects for Washington County Transit, Montgomery County, and Prince George's County, as well as operating assistance for Washington County Transit. Additionally, the MARC Maintenance and Layover Facility is being added within the Wilmington Area Planning Council MPO TIP. This project was previously listed in the Baltimore TIP, as it was originally planned for Harford County.

These projects do not alter any conformity findings nor interfere with any State Implementation Plan projects. Per agreement, a joint Federal Transit Administration (FTA)/Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) approval of these STIP Amendments are not required. In accordance with your procedures to incorporate the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Programs (MTIPs) into the STIP by reference, these projects are part of an approved amendment to the approved FY 2013 STIP. FTA hereby approves the continuation of these projects as Amendments to the STIP. This approval does not constitute an obligation of Federal funds. FTA finalizes Federal funding for projects included in the STIP upon approval of a grant application.
