The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect an update to one project in Saint Mary's County, called the MD 5 Corridor Study (MD 246-MD 471), Great Mills, also known as MD 5, Point Lookout Road Intersections project. The MDOT has assigned Control #14-131 for this amendment.

The MDOT is requesting the amendment on behalf of the State Highway Administration (SHA). The Calvert – St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization (C-SMMPO) Board approved this action on January 7, 2016. This amendment adds additional funding to the Project Planning phase and moves Preliminary Engineering funding to later years beyond the current program years of the C-SMMPO FY 2015-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the MD 5 Corridor Study (MD 246-MD 471), Great Mills project. The signed resolution and SHA's supporting documentation are attached.


Dear Ms. Murphy:
