The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect actions taken by the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB). The modifications update four transit projects: 2016 Bus and Rail Preventive Maintenance, Light Rail Mid-Life Overhaul, Metro Railcar and Signaling System Rehab and Replacement, and Bus and Rail System Preservation and Improvement. The MDOT has assigned Control #14-137 for these administrative modifications.

The BRTB approved the 2016 Bus and Rail Preventive Maintenance project on April 14, 2016 and approved the Light Rail Mid-Life Overhaul, Metro Railcar and Signaling System Rehab and Replacement, and Bus and Rail System Preservation and Improvement projects on May 10, 2016.
