### Section 3.3 Public Transportation Programs

The County Commuter is the program manager for FTA §5307 Urbanized Formula funds for public transportation in Hagerstown, MD. Washington County, MD is the official recipient of the FTA funding and then, by agreement sub-allocates the federal funds to the County Commuter. In turn, the County Commuter provides public transit services for the City and eligible surrounding areas. The County Commuter recovers 50% of its operating costs less fare revenues and 80% of its capital improvement and preventive maintenance expenses as well as planning expenditures from FTA. Washington County then provides the County Commuter with cash funds and in-kind services for the remaining expenses as required for local match of the FTA program. With the cooperation of the Maryland Transit Administration, the County Commuter also receives funding for qualifying projects through the FTA §5309 Statewide Grant Program. In the past, the MTA has assisted the County Commuter with matching funds for capital improvements such as vehicle maintenance and replacements under the FTA §5309 Program.
