HOW?

Men and women interested in joining the Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) Police Force may attend a special recruitment event held in Central Maryland region. The event, conducted by the Recruiting & Selection Unit, may last from 4 to 8 hours based on the applicant success.

Attendees must **be prepared to participate in the Agility Testing events immediately following the registration process (proper fitness attire is expected)**. Those candidates that successfully complete the MDTA physical agility test will receive information about the MDTA Police and the application process. Applicants that successfully complete this phase of the process will be given direction to our Headquarters building for orientation, written testing and processing. You will be required to be dressed in professional business attire to attend.

Applicants that successfully pass the physical agility and entry level written exam will be scheduled for additional processing

- **A black ink pen and note pad or calendar/planner.**
- **Appropriate athletic attire (i.e., sweat pants and T-shirts) is expected. The MDTA Police reserve the right to deny admittance to anyone wearing clothing deemed inappropriate and/or offensive.** (successful applicants will need a change of professional attire for additional process)
- **Additional processing attire: Appropriate business attire (a jacket and tie for men and a pant suit or skirt for women) is expected. Please do not arrive for the second phase of testing in casual attire such as khakis or jeans as you will not be admitted. The MDTAP reserves the right to deny admittance to anyone wearing clothing deemed inappropriate and/or offensive.**
