

RE: County Priority Letter

Dear Secretary Porcari:

Please be advised that Somerset County is hereby submitting the following transportation priority list for Somerset County.

1. Re-design of a very dangerous intersection located at the intersection of U.S. 13 and Route 413, Westover, Maryland. This intersection has been the location of several fatal accidents. For safety reasons, this area needs the immediate attention of the State.
2. Traffic study at the intersection of U.S. 13 and C.N. Baughan Road. This road has an increased volume when school is in session. It is the main access road to Washington High School. Due to the close proximity of the railway it makes the intersection of U.S. 13 and C.N. Baughan extremely dangerous as school buses stop before crossing railway, cars backup and are routinely backed up on the travel portion of U.S. 13. For safety reasons, this area needs immediate attention from the state.
3. State "take over" of a section of Revells Neck Road, currently a County road, starting at the end of current state maintenance (ECI last entrance westward) to sign post road, approximately .7 miles. Wal-Mart has completed the purchase of the property adjacent to this portion of Revels Neck Road and plans for a large distribution center are in the near future.



4. Dualization of Maryland Route 413 from Crisfield to U.S. 13. (Needs to be entered into state plan).
5. A marine/barge terminal located in the City of Crisfield would have a tremendous economic impact not only in Somerset County but the entire interstate region. The harbor along the west side of Crisfield is already a federally maintained channel with deep water access. The terminal would move commodities such as grain, aggregate, etc. from the western shore to the eastern shore.
6. Deal Island Road, Route 363 widening, currently in the State Plan Needs Right- of- way and construction funding.
7. Overlay of Fairmount Road, Route 361, from Ring Road to Manokin.

During your annual fall visit, the Board would like to further discuss each item on our priority list. If any further information is needed, please do not hesitate to contact the Somerset County Commissioners' office.


