The Regional and Intermodal Planning Division (RIPD) is submitting the following amendment to the FY 2011-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Cumberland Urbanized Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO):

- Add the I-68 Cumberland Viaduct Bridge project for painting and repairs in the construction phase for \$14.5 million for FY 11. This project will be funded using NHS funds.
