
Dear Mr. Halligan:

We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control # 11-07) to modify the Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and FY 2011-2014 Baltimore Metropolitan Region Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The STIP/TIP is being modified to advance \$33.6 million federal funds from FY 2014 to FY 2011 for the Areawide Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation program to fund the I-695 bridge over Wilkens Avenue. The total cost of the Areawide Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation program would not change but still remain at \$111.3 million.

We accept this modification and find that it was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process, in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 134, 23 U.S.C. 135 and 49.
