**WHEREAS**, the Salisbury/Wicomico Metropolitan Planning Organization (S/WMPO) was established to conduct regional transportation planning for the S/WMPO area in accordance with Federal requirements;

**WHEREAS**, the S/WMPO Council is the governing body for the S/WMPO;

**WHEREAS**, the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT), Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT), and the S/WMPO prepared the FY 2017 – FY 2020 (Maryland) and FY 2016 – FY 2019 (Delaware) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the S/WMPO Area in compliance with applicable Federal programs and regulations;

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2017 – FY 2020 (Maryland) and FY 2016 – FY 2019 (Delaware) TIP was reviewed by the S/WMPO Technical Advisory Committee, which made a favorable recommendation to forward the document to the S/WMPO Council for their review and action; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2017 – FY 2020 (Maryland) and FY 2016 – FY 2019 (Delaware) TIP was available for public review and comment for a period of no less than 15-days prior to an action of the S/WMPO Council at an advertised public hearing on March 10, 2016, which no public comments were received; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the S/WMPO Council does hereby adopt the FY 2017 – FY 2020 (Maryland) and FY 2016 – FY 2019 (Delaware) TIP, dated March 10, 2016, for the S/WMPO Area.
