This is to acknowledge receipt of and the processing of Maryland Transit Administration's request for an Administrative Modification of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board's (TPB) FY 2015-2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TPB's modified FY 2015-2020 TIP now reflects \$409,000 less in Section 5307 funding in FY 2016 for Small Urban Systems – Operating Assistance (TIP ID 2594) as requested.
