We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control #19-14) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2022 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Specifically, the STIP is being amended to include the FY 2020-FY 2023 Baltimore Region Transportation Board (BRTB) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP was adopted by the BRTB on July 23, 2019. On July 29, 2019, FHWA and FTA approved the Air Quality Conformity Determination for the MPO's Maximize2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and the FY 2020-2023 TIP.

We accept this amendment and find that it was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process, in accordance with the requirements of 23 U.S.C. 134, 23 U.S.C. 135 and 49.
