Dear Mr. Murrill and Ms. Crews:

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for three administrative modifications to transit projects in the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board's (BRTB) *2017 – 2020 Baltimore Region Transportation (TIP)*. The TIP has been modified to update North Avenue Rising (42-1702-09), MTA Core Bus and Paratransit Vehicle Replacement (40-1601-05), and Metro Railcar and Signaling Systems Rehab and Replacement (40-1303-64). The

MDOT has assigned Control #17-11 for these modifications. The BRTB Executive Committee approved the administrative modification on January 4, 2017.

Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) has adjusted North Avenue Rising by shifting funds to the PE phase from state construction funds. MTA has added funds to MTA Core Bus and Paratransit Vehicle Replacement and Metro Railcar and Signaling Systems Rehab and Replacement that were flexed from STP funding to 5307 funding referred to as 5307 Flex. All of the remaining funding sources have remained the same for all three projects.
