The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for an amendment to the Small Urban Transit System in the Calvert - St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization's (CSMMPO) FY 2015-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP has been amended to increase Capital Assistance for Transit Services provided by Non-Profits operating in Calvert/St. Mary's County (S-2018-14) in the amount of \$132,000. The CSMMPO Council approved the amendment to its TIP on June 14, 2018. The MDOT has assigned Control #17-110 for this modifications to the STIP.

A RESOLUTION BY THE CALVERT-ST. MARY'S METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-2021 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Calvert-St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization Council is the governing body for the Calvert-St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization ("C-SMMPO");

WHEREAS, the Calvert-St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Lexington Park—California—Chesapeake Ranch Estates region, approved the FY2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program ("TIP") at its May 18, 2017 meeting;

WHEREAS, federal regulations require that all transportation-related projects must be listed in the approved Transportation Improvement Program with accurate funding schedules in order to be eligible for federal funding;

WHEREAS, the TIP consists of projects included in, and in support of, the region's long-range transportation plan and ongoing short-range planning efforts;

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation's Transportation Authority ("MTA") is requesting an amendment to the FY2018-2021 TIP to reflect an increase in capital assistance in Section 5310 Federal funding in the amount of One Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$132,000) for the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program transit projects (TIP ID# S-2018-14) in FY2018, as reflected in the attachment hereto and incorporated here by reference; and

WHEREAS, this increase in Federal funding can be attributed to a special solicitation that was announced as a result of lapsing FY2016 funds that were previously unobligated; Section 5310 Federal funding will be used to expand the current small bus fleet by one (1) additional bus and to provide mobility management to the region.




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

The MTA is requesting an amendment to the Calvert – St. Mary’s MPO FY 2018-2021 TIP. MTA has increased Section 5310 Federal funding in FY18 in the amount of \$132K for capital assistance for the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program, TIP ID # S-2018-14.

This increase in Federal funding can be attributed to a special solicitation that was announced as a result of lapsing FY16 funds that were previously unobligated. Section 5310 Federal funding will be used to expand the current small bus fleet by one (1) additional bus and to provide mobility management to the region.

The proposed action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current TIP, which continues to be fiscally constrained.
