We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control #17-123) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Specifically, the STIP is being amended to include the FY 2019-FY 2022 Baltimore Region Transportation Board's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP was adopted by the MPO Board on June 24, 2018. On August 27, 2018, FHWA and FTA approved the Air Quality Conformity Determination for the MPO's Maximize2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and the FY 2019-2022 TIP.

We accept this amendment and find that it was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process, in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 134, 23 U.S.C. 135 and 49.
