**SUBJECT:** Administrative Modification to the FY 2017-2020 STIP

The MTA is requesting an administrative modification to the FY 2017-2020 STIP. MTA has increased Section 5310 Federal funding in FY18 in the amount of \$154K for capital and operating assistance for the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program, STIP ID # MTA-2017-01.

This increase in Federal funding can be attributed to a special solicitation that was announced as a result of lapsing FY16 funds that were previously unobligated. These funds will be used for mobility management and to replace two (2) small buses. Worcester County Commission of Aging will also receive funding for operating assistance.

The proposed action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current TIP, which continues to be fiscally constrained.
