The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for one Amendment to the STIP for a statewide project: Areawide Congestion Management specifically to add the national freight fluidity monitoring program in FY 2017.

As this is a statewide project, this project has been shared with the state's Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) for informational purposes. The MPOs have not taken and will not take action. The MDOT has assigned Control #17-7 for this amendment.

The Areawide Congestion Management amendment will be adding \$600,000 to facilitate the inclusion of national freight fluidity monitoring program.


Dear Ms. Murphy:
