**Report of Activities for
Fiscal Year 2013**

(July 1, 2012– June 30, 2013)

INTRODUCTION

This Report highlights the activities of the Transportation Professional Services Selection Board (TPSSB) during Fiscal Year 2013 in conjunction with the selection of consultants for Architectural/Engineering (A/E) projects processed through the TPSSB, for the Maryland Department of Transportation (Department), in conformance with applicable laws, regulations and internal guidelines.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The major facts and conclusions contained in this report are as follows:

1. The TPSSB finalized 41 consultant recommendations in Fiscal Year 2013, compared to 36 in Fiscal Year 2012. The total awards for these 41 recommendations amounted to approximately \$205.3 Million, compared to \$184.1 Million in Fiscal Year 2012.
2. Of the total 41 recommendations, all were at least \$2 Million and were based upon an evaluation of technical proposals and negotiated prices.
3. The total time required to finalize recommendations on a negotiated basis averaged 29.3 months, with 28 months consumed by Transportation Agencies and 1.3 months by the TPSSB. (These averages exclude major delays attributable to non-selection related matters). This is an increase of 10.8 months as compared to Fiscal Year 2012 in time consumed by Transportation Agencies and a increase of .9 months for the time required by the TPSSB. The increase in the time required to make A&E contract awards can primarily be attributed to delays at SHA in reviewing all active A&E procurements as a result of a Special Legislative Audit and a Regular Audit that occurred in June of 2011 and November of 2011, respectively. SHA has completed these reviews and implemented corrective action for all A&E procurements underway.

MINORITY BUSINESS PARTICIPATION/DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS PARTICIPATION

Of the 41 projects in Fiscal Year 2013, 122 firms were used as subcontractors, and of those subcontractors, 72 were MBE/DBE firms.

CHANGES IN LAWS, REGULATIONS, & INTERNAL GUIDELINES

In Fiscal Year 2013, there were no changes to COMAR 21.12.01, 21.12.02 or Sections 12-303 or 13-304 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

CONSULTANT RECOMMENDATIONS

During Fiscal Year 2013, the TPSSB met 8 times, and processed 41 recommendations on a negotiated basis involving 25 consultant firms as compared to 26 consultant firms in 2012. The total cost of the 41 finalized recommendations amounted to approximately \$205.3 Million.

Detailed information on the 41 finalized recommendations is provided as Attachments II - V. An analysis of the data on these Attachments, and other information available in TPSSB files, reveals the following:

1. Projects by Cost Categories:

Costs for each of the 41 recommendations for which consultants were recommended on a negotiated basis ranged from approximately \$1,500,000 to \$15,000,000.

The following tabulation summarizes these recommendations by cost categories:

2. Recommendations by Technical Proposals/Negotiated Prices:

41 recommendations were finalized based on evaluation of technical proposals and negotiated prices.

Negotiating Teams were able to negotiate a satisfactory contract with the top-ranked firms in all instances at a price, which they determined to be fair, competitive and reasonable.

There is a possibility that the TPSSB could consider a Transportation Agency's recommendation of the award of a contract to the second highest ranked firm. In addition, in cases where simultaneous negotiations with two or more firms for the awarding of identical open-end contracts from one reduced candidate list have not been satisfactory, the Transportation Agency may negotiate with, and recommend the award of a contract to a lower ranked firm. Neither of these situations occurred in Fiscal Year 2013.

3. Time Involved in Finalizing Recommendations:

Of the 41 recommendations, which were finalized on a negotiated basis, the total time required for a selection ranged from 9.5 to 49.6 months, depending on the nature and complexity of the project, averaging 29.3 months per selection, excluding major delays attributable to non-selection related matters. This was measured from solicitation of interest from firms, to final approval by the TPSSB. Related actions occurring during this period were as follows:

An average of 28 months per selection was consumed by appropriate Transportation Agencies in making specific selection recommendations to the TPSSB. This covered time necessary for public announcements for solicitation of interest from firms, evaluation of candidate firms, any de-briefings of firms not on reduced candidate lists, preparation of requests for technical and price proposals, and evaluation of these proposals and price negotiations in order to make selection recommendations to the TPSSB.

An average of 1.3 months per selection was required for the TPSSB to review and finalize all selection recommendations made by Transportation Agencies, including waiting periods necessary for public announcements for TPSSB meetings, and any de-briefings through Transportation Agencies of firms not recommended for selection.

The increase in the time required to make A&E contract awards can primarily be attributed to delays at SHA in reviewing all active A&E procurements as a result of a Special Legislative Audit and a Regular Audit that occurred in June of 2011 and November of 2011, respectively. SHA has completed these reviews and implemented corrective action for all A&E procurements underway.

CERTIFICATION FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

During Fiscal Year 2013, the TPSSB received and recorded a total of 9 certifications by the Secretary involving A/E services, which at the time of certification could not feasibly or economically be provided through existing in-house resources, and appropriate Transportation Agencies were directed to proceed with the selection of consultants.


