

# MBE Only Certification Overview

## **One Certification Agency:**

The Department of Social and Economic Mobility (DoSEM) is the official certification agency for the State

### **Area of Contracting Opportunities:**

Contracts awarded by any Maryland agency and most counties, cities, and municipalities

# **Maryland State Certification:**

1. Minority Business Enterprise (MBE)

#### **Four Steps to Certification:**

- 1. **Application** applicant submits completed application and supporting documentation to **Office of Minority Business Enterprise (OMBE)**
- 2. **Investigation** OMBE staff reviews submitted documentation and conducts an on-site/jobsite visit during which the applicant is interviewed
- 3. **Evaluation** The application and supporting documentation is evaluated to determine whether the firm meets the MBE program requirements. The Certification Committee evaluates whether the applicant firm meets Federal Certification program requirements.
- 4. **Determination** A written determination is issued from OMBE
- 5. *Approved*: letter is sent listing the approved NAICS codes
- 6. *Denied*: letter is sent detailing the evidence in the record that supports each reason for the denial (firm may appeal the denial and/or reapply in 5 months.

### **Five Eligibility Standards:**

- 1. **Ownership** must be at least 51% owned by one or more individuals who are minorities, women, or person with disabilities.
- 2. **Minority Status** members of the following groups are presumed to be a minority: Women, Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific Americans, and Subcontinent Asian Americans.
- 3. **Control** the minority applicant(s) must have an overall understanding of, and managerial and technical competence and experience directly related to the type of business in which the firm is seeking certification.
- 4. **Personal Net Worth** each individual owner must complete the personal net worth form.

  MBE cap: \$2,192,035
- 5. **Size** applicant must meet the small business size standards established by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA)
