The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 – 2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect the following amendment to the statewide highway portion of the FY 2019 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The MDOT has designated this amendment as Control #19-120, and the supporting documentation is attached.

### **PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM**

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for its approval the following STIP amendment.

### **SUMMARY**

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP to reflect the following action.

### ANALYSIS

*Statewide Bridge Inspection (AW139W)* – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project, AW139W, to the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP and the addition of \$9,533,000 to planning funding for this project. This amendment ensures the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed expenditures and inspection schedule in FY 2019-2022. This project's total cost, including funding programmed beyond the FY 2019-2022 STIP, is \$19,091,000. In addition to State funding, this funding will be comprised of federal NHPP and STBG funding at levels reflecting MDOT SHA's use of toll credits. This project and these funds will enable MDOT SHA to continue its biannual bridge inspections statewide in FY 2022-2023.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2021-2026 Consolidated Transportation Program (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/ Index.html) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP TIP/STIPandTIP.html).
