ANALYSIS

MD 33 (Tilghman Island Road) Oak Creek Bridge Replacement (TA2331) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project, TA2331, to the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP and to fund \$620,000 for the design work. This amendment ensures the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2019-2022. The MDOT SHA anticipates beginning construction in Spring 2026 and opening improvements to traffic in late 2027.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

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In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2021-2026 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
