The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 – 2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect the following changes for the Statewide Planning and Research Program to the highway section of the FY 2019 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The MDOT has designated this amendment as Control #19-143, and the supporting documentation is attached.

This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project and \$90,000 in SHRP2 funding to the FY 2019-2022 STIP. This project enables MDOT SHA to delivery training materials as part of the 2021 National Operations Academy curriculum. This will covers MDOT SHA's programmed expenditures for FY 2022 in this category.

The Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program continues to be fiscally constrained.
