ANALYSIS

Grantsville Local Access Road (AR2001) - This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project to the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP and the addition of funding for this project. It reflects the addition of \$1,000,000 for design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction for AR2001, a locallysponsored project funded with federal Appalachian Highway Development System funding. The project sponsor, Garrett County, anticipates beginning design in FY 2020 and construction in FY 2021.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2020-2025 Consolidated Transportation Program (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP TIP/STIPandTIP.html).
