The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect changes to one highway project in the FY 2021-2024 National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

This modification reflects MDOT State Highway Administration's (SHA) updated programmed expenditures and project schedule for the MD 212A Urban Reconstruction Project. PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming notify the FHWA Maryland Division of this administrative modification.

SUMMARY

On May 28, 2020, Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Department of Transportation Planning (MWCOP DTP) staff approved the following MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA)-requested administrative modification to the FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP.

ANALYSIS

MD 212A Urban Reconstruction (TPB 6529 MC #19-61 06/03/2020) – This modification reflects the addition of \$1,160,000 to FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP planning/design funding and \$139,000 to FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP right-of-way acquisition funding. This modification ensures the FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP reflects MDOT SHA’s updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2021-2024. This project’s total cost is increasing from \$25 million to \$26 million. Per the October 29, 2014 memorandum of understanding executed by MDOT and the FHWA, this action is eligible to be processed

Ms. Heather Murphy
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as an administrative modification as TPB 6529 MC #19-61 06/03/2020 is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2020-2025 Consolidated Transportation Program (<http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html>) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP_TIP/STIPandTIP.html).

Please be advised of this modification to the FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP to reflect the funding information provided in the attachments. I looked at the attached TIP sheet you provided. While the language in the description box at the bottom the TIP sheet is correct, the flows for FY 20 and FY 21 are incorrect. It appears in the TIP sheet that the funds were added to FY 20 instead of FY 21, where I asked the funds to be added. I'm adding \$1,299,000 in STBG and State funds for 2021 in the FY 2019-2024 TPB TIP for TPB 6529. These funds include \$928,000 (STBG) and \$232,000 (State) for the preliminary engineering phase in FY 2021. These funds also include \$139,000 (State) for the right-of-way phase in FY 2021. It should appear in FY 21 in the TIP sheet like it appears in the project in the ITIP snapshot below.

Also in the language highlighted in yellow in the email below should be deleted. We are not adding anything to FY 20.

Please make these changes as soon as you can and provide an updated TIP sheet. Thanks.
