The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby requests to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 – 2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect an amendment to the highway portion of the Hagerstown Metropolitan Planning Organization (HEPMPO) FY 2021–2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The approval and supporting documentation are attached. This amendment has been designated as MDOT Control #19-84.

This requested amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP of a new project, I-70 Roadway and Bridges Improvements (I-81 to Bower Avenue) with the addition of \$2,353,000 to HEPMPO W2021-08 design funding. Only the first two years, FY2021 and FY2022, of the project are reflected in the STIP for \$1,038,000. The MDOT SHA has begun design for this project, which will replace and/or rehabilitate six I-70 bridges at I-81, US 11 (Virginia Avenue), and the Winchester and Western Railroad Virginia Division and complete associated roadway upgrades using State funding. MDOT SHA now intends to obligate eligible federal funding as well towards this project, requiring this TIP amendment.

AMENDMENT TO THE 2021-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Hagerstown/Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization (HEPMPO) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Hagerstown-MD-WV-PA urbanized area and region, and includes official representatives of the cities of Hagerstown and Martinsburg, the towns of Washington County and of Berkeley County, the counties of Berkeley, Jefferson and Washington as well as representatives of the Maryland Department of Transportation, the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Washington County Transit, and the Eastern Panhandle Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Hagerstown/Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Hagerstown-MD-WV-PA urbanized area and region, approved the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program at its May 20, 2020 meeting, with federal concurrence received June 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, federal regulations require that all transportation-related projects must be listed in the approved Transportation Improvement Program with accurate funding schedules in order to be eligible for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program consists of projects included in, and in support of, the region's long-range transportation plan and ongoing short-range planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration has requested approval of an amendment to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program through the approved Transportation Improvement Program amendment process; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration is requesting to amend one new project the I-70 Roadway and Bridge Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program, as amended, continues to display financial reasonableness and re-affirms the appropriate project selection criteria whereby all requirements for a Transportation Improvement Program in the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act are met; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Transportation Improvement Program amendments were publicized for a 14-day review from October 7, 2020 to October 20, 2020. No comments were received on this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hagerstown/Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization, approves the attached amendments to the 2021-2024

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to HEPMPO for its approval the following TIP amendment.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP to reflect the following action.

ANALYSIS

I-70 Roadway and Bridges Improvements (I-81 to Bower Avenue) (HEPMPO W2021-08) – This requested amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP of a new project, I-70 Roadway and Bridges Improvements (I-81 to Bower Avenue) and the addition of \$2,353,000 to HEPMPO W2021-08 design funding. The MDOT SHA already has begun design for this project, which will replace and/or rehabilitate six I-70 bridges at I-81, US 11 (Virginia Avenue), and the Winchester and Western Railroad Virginia Division and complete associated roadway upgrades, using State funding, but MDOT SHA now intends to obligate federal funding, requiring this TIP amendment. Following design, MDOT SHA anticipates beginning construction in the Spring of 2024.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2020-2025 Consolidated Transportation Program (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP_TIP/STIPandTIP.html).
