

MDOT MTA is requesting an Administrative Modification to the FY 2021-2024 BMC/BRTB TIP for capital assistance in urban transit systems and rural transit systems, TIP ID # 40-1602-05 and # 40-9501-05.

MDOT MTA will be decreasing Urban Transit Systems Capital FY21 federal funding by \$296K in Section 5307 and \$182K in Section 5339. The decrease in funding can be attributed to the difference in forecasted projections versus actual award for the region.
