The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby administratively modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 – 2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect the following administrative modification to the transit portion of the Cumberland Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) FY 2019 – FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The MDOT has designated this administrative modification as Control #19-92 and the documentation is attached.

MDOT MTA is increasing Section 5307 federal funding for capital assistance by \$194K in FY 2021. This source of funding will be used to provide continued preventive maintenance throughout the region, three small bus replacements, and a garage door replacement. The match that was originally planned for the state is now being provided by the locals for current and future capital awards due to reduced revenues from the COVID-19 pandemic.

MDOT MTA is increasing Section 5307 federal funding for capital assistance by \$194K in FY21. This source of funding will be used to provide continued preventive maintenance throughout the region, three small bus replacements, and a garage door replacement.

The match that was originally planned for the state is now being provided by the locals for current and future capital awards due to reduced revenues from the COVID-19 pandemic.

MDOT MTA is also changing the source of Section 5307 matching funds for operating assistance.

The proposed action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current TIP, which continues to be fiscally constrained.
