WHEREAS, the Calvert - St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization ("C-SMMPO") was established to conduct regional transportation planning for the C-SMMPO area in accordance with Federal requirements;

WHEREAS, the Calvert - St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization Council is the governing body for the C-SMMPO;

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation and the C-SMMPO prepared the FY 2021 - FY 2024 Transportation Improvement Program ("TIP");

WHEREAS, following due publication of notice that was consistent with the requirements of the MPO's adopted Bylaws and Public Participation Process, a 15-day public comment period extending from May 20, through June 5, 2020 was instituted prior to the public meeting and, following an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting of the C-SMMPO Council on June 10, 2020, the Council adopted the FY 2021-FY 2024 TIP;

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation-State Highway Administration ("MDOT-SHA") has requested an Amendment to the C-SMMPO FY 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that reflects changes on the MD 5 Great Mills Study project;

WHEREAS, following due publication of notice that was consistent with the requirements of the MPO's adopted Bylaws and Public Participation Process, a 15-day public comment period extending from December 4, 2020, through December 18, 2020 was instituted prior to the public meeting and, following an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting of the C-SMMPO Council on December 18, 2020, the Council found that it is in the best interest of the C-SMMPO to adopt the requested amendment to the FY 2021-FY 2024 TIP.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby adopt the amendment to the FY 2021-FY 2024 TIP as presented and attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, to replace that same page within the FY 2021-FY 2024 TIP adopted June 10, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to C-SMMPO for its approval the following TIP amendment.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2021-2024 C-SMMPO TIP to reflect the following action.

ANALYSIS

MD 5 Great Mills Study (C-SMMPO S-2018-08 MC #19-64 06/23/2020) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of \$1,242,000 to FY 2021-2024 C-SMMPO TIP funding for S-2018-08 MC #19-64 06/23/2020. The MDOT SHA requests this amendment, which primarily shifts previously programmed funds, in order that the FY 2021-2024 C-SMMPO TIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2021-2024. This project's total estimated cost, including for years prior to, during, and beyond the FY 2021-2024 C-SMMPO TIP, is decreasing from \$33 million to \$28 million. If construction funding is identified, MDOT SHA anticipates advertising this project for construction in the Winter of 2023-2024.

Ms. Heather Murphy
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The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2020-2025 Consolidated Transportation Program (<http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html>) and FY 2021-2024 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP_TIP/STIPandTIP.html).

Comments MDOT SHA is fully funding planning and design ("ENG" below) and right-of-way acquisition, totaling \$11.2 million in fiscal years before, during, and beyond the C-SMMPO FY 2021-2024 TIP. In addition, MDOT SHA is funding \$0.2 million, before, during and beyond the C-SMMPO FY 2021-2024 TIP, for utility relocations, documented in the TIP as construction funding. Construction of capital funding remains to be funded and is estimated to cost an additional \$16.8 million. Total project cost is estimated at \$28.2 million.
