Directions to the Leggett Executive Office Building:

If walking, biking, or rolling: Bike parking is available on Monroe Street outside the building. Bikes may also be brought up to the conference room. A Capital Bikeshare dock is also available at the intersection of Monroe Street and Monroe Place, just north of the building. Use your favorite bike map or app to plan your route, or consult MDOT's [level of traffic stress map](#).

If taking transit: The Rockville Metro, MARC, and Amtrak station is located approximately two blocks (5 minute walk) east of the building. To reach the building from the station, exit on the pedestrian bridge and follow signs toward Rockville Town Center. When reaching Monroe Street, turn south and travel about 1 block to the building. Additionally, RideOn and WMATA buses service downtown Rockville. RideOn routes 44, 46, 47, 54, 56, and 63 stop in front of 101 Monroe Street. Crosswalks are present at the intersection with Monroe Place to cross and enter the building.

If driving: Paid public parking is available at the Council Office Building Garage located at 100 Maryland Ave, Rockville, MD 20850. The visitor parking entrance is accessible from E. Jefferson Street or from Monroe Street. (Note: The parking garage at 101 Monroe St is only for employees and permit parking.) After parking, cross E Jefferson Street and walk north on Monroe Street. The building is located on the west side of the street.
