**Re: Amendment to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program, MDOT Control #22-134**

Dear Mr. Anderson:

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) requested approval of an Amendment to the FY 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (Control #22-134 dated June 5, 2024). This Amendment updates the STIP to include the Calvert-St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization (C-SMMPO) FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), approved by the C-SMMPO Council on April 22, 2024.

We have completed our review, and concur with FHWA's approval of this amendment, dated June 10, 2024. We find that the C-SMMPO FY 2025-2028 TIP was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process, in accordance with 23 USC 134 and 135 and 49 USC Sections 5303-5305.

This approval does not constitute an obligation of Federal funds. FTA finalizes Federal funding for projects included in the STIP upon approval of a grant application.
