Dear Mr. Murrill and Ms. Crews:

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 – 2025 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect an administrative modification to the Hagerstown Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization (HEPMPO) FY 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This modification updates two existing projects in the TIP. The approval and the detailed supporting documentation are attached. This administrative modification has been designated as MDOT Control #22-14.

The first action reflects the addition of state and federal funding to the TIP for right-of-way acquisition and construction funding for the I-70 Roadway and Bridges Improvements I-81 to Bower Avenue project (HEPMPO W2021-08). The total cost of this project is increasing from \$39 million to \$41 million. Design is underway and construction will begin in the Spring of 2024.

The second action reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule for the I-70 Crystal Falls Drive Bridges Replacement project (HEPMPO W2022-04). There is a reduction in funding programmed in the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP but an overall increase in the funding for the years of the MDOT STIP. The total cost of the project is increasing from \$27 million to \$28 million.

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming request HEPMPO staff approve the following TIP administrative modifications and, upon HEPMPO approval, notify the FHWA Maryland Division of these administrative modifications.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests HEPMPO administratively modify the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP to reflect the following two actions.

ANALYSIS

I-70 Roadway and Bridges Improvements (I-81 to Bower Avenue) (HEPMPO W2021-08) – This requested administrative modification reflects minor increases in funding for HEPMPO W2021-08 planning/design and right-of-way acquisition and the addition of \$1,199,000 to HEPMPO W2021-08

construction funding. This modification ensures the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2021-2024. Specifically, this modification documents MDOT SHA's use of federal funding for overhead costs associated with the construction phase of this project. This project's total cost, including funding programmed in fiscal years prior to and subsequent to the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP, is increasing from \$39 million to \$41 million. Per the October 29, 2014 memorandum of understanding executed by MDOT and the FHWA, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as HEPMPO W2021-08 is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost. Design is underway and will proceed through the Fall of 2023, construction will begin in the Spring of 2024, and construction will be completed in 2025-2026.

I-70 Crystal Falls Drive Bridges Replacement (HEPMPO W2022-04) – This requested administrative modification reflects a decrease of \$372,000 from HEPMPO W2022-04 planning/design funding and a decrease of \$5,587,000 from HEPMPO W2022-04 construction funding during the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP. This modification ensures the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2021-2024. While funding programmed in FY 2021-2024 is decreasing, overall funding actually is increasing. Specifically, MDOT SHA is completing design on a quicker schedule and now knowing the overall schedule for construction has reflowed these funds to reflect this schedule more accurately, extending in FY 2025, beyond the timespan of this TIP. In addition, this modification documents MDOT SHA's use of federal funding for overhead costs associated with the construction phase of this project. The project's total cost, including funding programmed in fiscal years prior to and subsequent to the FY 2021-2024 HEPMPO TIP, is increasing from \$27 million to \$28 million. Per the 2014 MOU, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as HEPMPO W2022-04 is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost. Design is underway and will proceed through the Winter of 2021-2022. Construction is anticipated to begin in the Summer of 2022 and be completed in 2024.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) reports document MDOT's requested modifications with respect to funding for the above projects. These requested actions will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. MDOT published funding details in the FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
