Dear Mr. Anderson:

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) requested approval of an Amendment to the FY 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (Control #22-146 dated July 9, 2024). This Amendment updates the STIP to include the Wilmington Area Planning Council (WILMAPCO) FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), approved by the WILMAPCO Council on May 23, 2024.

We have completed our review, and concur with FHWA's approval of this amendment, dated August 7, 2024. We find that the WILMAPCO FY 2025-2028 TIP was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process, in accordance with 23 USC 134 and 135 and 49 USC Sections 5303-5305.

This approval does not constitute an obligation of Federal funds. FTA finalizes Federal funding for projects included in the STIP upon approval of a grant application.
