We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control #22-150) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect changes to the following areawide projects on behalf of the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA):

- Areawide Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation (\$10.4M)
- Areawide Environmental Projects (\$400K)
- Areawide Congestion Management (\$3.2M)
- Areawide Resurfacing and Rehabilitation (\$14.4M)
- Areawide Safety and Spot Improvements (\$14M)
- OMT Geotechnical Asset Management (FY 25) (\$400K)
- OMT Pavement Program Development (FY 25) (1.76M)
- OMT ARAN pavement network condition data collection (FY 25) (\$880K)
- OMT Skid Pavement Network Condition Data Collection (FY 25) (\$640K)
- OMT Fund 77 Pavement & System Preservation Planning (FY25) (\$960K)
