We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control #22-151) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect the addition of three new projects, Areawide Carbon Reduction Program (\$8.68M), Solar Installation at Transportation Facilities (\$2.75M), Security Improvements for Transportation Facilities (\$4.60M), and one existing project Bridge Replacement - Livingston Road (-\$7.4M) in the FY 2023-2026 National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on behalf of the State Highway Administration (SHA), the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT), and the Prince George's County Department of Public Works & Transportation (DPW&T).
