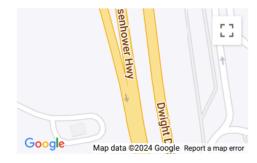

This is to acknowledge the receipt and processing of the MDOT SHA requests for administrative modifications to the projects listed below in the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board's (TPB) FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Approved under TIP Action 23-44, the TPB's modified FY 2023-2026 TIP now reflects updated descriptive and funding information, as described in the attached materials for the projects and programs requested in the original e-mail.
