We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control #22-164) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This amendment reflects changes to three existing projects and the addition of three new projects within the Maryland portion of the Hagerstown/Eastern Panhandle Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (HEPMPO) FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as submitted on behalf of the Washington County Division of Engineering and the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA). The proposed changes are detailed below.
