Project Benefits:

The TOD Station Square Project is in the state-designated TOD Area & was included in the 2012 Aberdeen TOD Master Plan. Benefits include: 1) removing a physical barrier separating areas of vulnerable population from transit and transportation services, employment, education, and other services, 2) reconnects the historic East/West side of the City, 3) improves the physical conditions for individuals with mobility impairments, 4) stimulates TOD & mixed-use development in the TOD area, Opportunity Zone, HUB Zone, and Enterprise Zone, & attract developers for public-private partnerships, 5) reduce vehicle dependency & expand passenger ridership of local & regional rail & public transport.

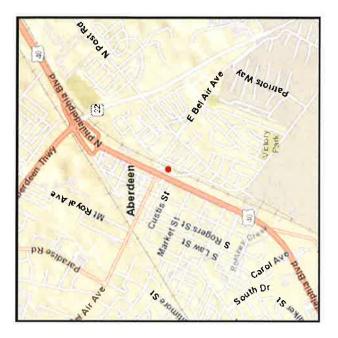
