The BRTB Executive Committee approved the enclosed Administrative Modification to the 2023 – 2026 Baltimore Region Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and noted it is the first TIP modification to include new funding from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA). 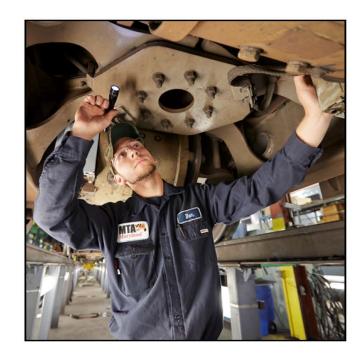
