### AMENDMENT TO THE 2023 – 2026 BALTIMORE REGION TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Baltimore region, encompassing the Baltimore Urbanized Area, and includes official representatives of the cities of Annapolis and Baltimore, the counties of Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford, Howard, and Queen Anne's as well as representatives of the Maryland Department of Transportation, the Maryland Department of the Environment, the Maryland Department of Planning, the Maryland Transit Administration, and Annapolis Transit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Baltimore region, approved the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program for the Baltimore region at its August 23, 2022 meeting, with federal approval on September 7, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, federal regulations require that all transportation-related projects must be listed in the approved Transportation Improvement Program with accurate funding schedules in order to be eligible for federal funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Improvement Program consists of projects included in, and in support of, the region's long-range transportation plan and ongoing short-range planning efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, Howard County has requested approval of one amendment to the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program through the approved Transportation Improvement Program amendment process; and

**WHEREAS**, Howard County is requesting to amend the Bridge Repair and Deck Replacement project in the 2023-2026 TIP. Howard County is adding funds for engineering, and Construction in FY 2023 through FY 2026 necessitating the amendment of this project in the 2023-2026 TIP (see attachment); and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Improvement Program, as amended, continues to display financial reasonableness and re-affirms the appropriate project selection criteria whereby all requirements for a Transportation Improvement Program in the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act are met; and

**WHEREAS**, this project is consistent with the federal emphasis on performancebased planning and programming, specifically the federal requirements pertaining to maintaining bridges in a state of good repair; and

**WHEREAS,** the Interagency Consultation Group has determined that this project is exempt according to the Conformity Rule (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93); and

**WHEREAS,** the proposed Transportation Improvement Program amendment was presented to the Technical Committee on February 7, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Baltimore region, approves the attached amendment to the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program for the Baltimore region and finds it to conform to the applicable Maryland State Implementation Plan and requirements of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments.



Dear Mr. Lang,

Howard County is requesting an amendment to the FY 2023-2026 TIP for the Bridge Repairs and Deck Replacement Project. The TIP ID No. for this project is 16-0436-13. The amendment updates the project scope to add ten "poor" rated bridges to ensure eligibility for Federal Aid for design and construction. The FY 2023-2026 TIP must include these bridges for receiving federal fund approval.

Additional details follow:

- No additional vehicle lanes will be added as part of these projects.
- Howard County is requesting federal money (80%) for design and construction
- Design and construction costs will be matched 20% by Howard County

The changes enabled by this amendment increase the project costs by:

- Adding \$40,000 in federal funds to engineering in FY 2023
- Adding \$10,000 in matching funds to engineering in FY 2023
- Adding \$80,000 in federal funds to construction in FY 2023
- Adding \$20,000 in matching funds to construction in FY 2023
- Adding \$960,000 in federal funds to engineering in FY 2024
- Adding \$240,000 in matching funds to engineering in FY 2024
- Adding \$280,000 in federal funds to construction in FY 2024
- Adding \$70,000 in matching funds to construction in FY 2024

- Adding \$640,000 in federal funds to engineering in FY 2025
- Adding \$160,000 in matching funds to engineering in FY 2025
- Adding \$2,040,000 in federal funds to construction in FY 2025
- Adding \$510,000 in matching funds to construction in FY 2025
- Adding \$80,000 in federal funds to engineering in FY 2026
- Adding \$20,000 in matching funds to engineering in FY 2026
- Adding \$1,760,000 in federal funds to construction in FY 2026
- Adding \$440,000 in matching funds to construction in FY 2026

These changes result in increasing the project cost by \$7,350,000 for a total cost of \$25,361,000. The Howard County CIP reflects these changes and Howard County's TIP projects continue to be fiscally constrained. The revised TIP form and additional information for this project is attached.

#### Description:

This project is to repair/replace bridge decks with a mix of county match and federal funding. The project also includes emergency structure reconstruction. The following bridges are included: River Rd. over Rockburn Branch; Henryton Rd. over tributary to the Patapsco River; Pindell School Rd. over Hammond Branch; Daisy Rd. over Little Cattail Creek; Pfefferkorn Rd. over Middle Patuxent River; Carroll Mill Rd. over Benson Branch; Sheppard Lane over Middle Patuxent River; Watersville Rd. over Hay Meadow Branch; Henryton Rd. over tributary to Patapsco River; Old Montgomery Rd. over Lake Elkhorn Branch; Tamar Drive over Little Patuxent River; Snowden River Pkwy over Robert Fulton Dr (SB & NB); Guilford Rd. over Middle Patuxent River; Park Circle Drive over Deep Run; Broken Land Pkwy over Little Patuxent River. Cost increased \$3.5 million as a result of refined engineers estimates. Justification:

This project will alleviate bridge deterioration and improve the safety and longevity of all bridges included in the bridge repair and rehabilitation program.

#### Amendment:

This amendment adds additional bridges and funds totaling \$50,000 for engineering and \$100,000 for construction in FY 2023; \$1,200,000 for engineering and \$350,000 for construction in FY 2024; \$800,000 for engineering and \$2,550,000 for construction in FY 2025; \$100,000 for engineering and \$2,200,000 for construction in FY 2025; \$100,000 for engineering and \$2,200,000 for construction in FY 2027.
