#### **ANALYSIS**

*MD 5 Great Mills (S-2018-08)* – This requested amendment reflects the addition of \$646,000 in design funding, \$352,000 in right-of-way funding, and \$12,160,000 in construction funding to FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP for S-2018-08. The SHA requests this amendment in order that the FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2028.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) reports document MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. These requested actions will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the draft FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program
